Use this list to create a crossword puzzle of at least 15 different "nonsense" words with clues. Write a narrative story, including all 5 parts (exposition, rising action, climax, falling action, and resolution) using the picture.</p>

Represent the data using a line plot and any other type of chart/graph. What are the pros and cons of the two ways to represent the data?
